In many ways, America is a very safety-conscious society. Many of us spend time contemplating the safety of the cars we buy, the foods we eat, and the activities we pursue at work and in our leisure time.

As your propane retailer, the safety of you and your family is important to us. Propane, when used properly, is a safe, cost-effective, clean-burning, convenient and efficient energy. As with other fuel types (fuel oil, electricity, natural gas, wood, etc.) it is extremely important to respect, understand, and know how to safely use your propane system.

Propane is a safe form of energy, but accidents can still happen. Reduce the possibility of accidents by having your propane system periodically inspected by a qualified service technician.

In addition, carefully read propane safety brochures that contain important information for you and your family. These brochures are mailed to all of our customers once a year. You can also pick up these safety brochures at Mr. Tire in Mullen and Valentine and the Propane Office in Ainsworth.

You and your family should use the scratch-and-sniff feature on one of the brochures to confirm that you can detect the odorant added to propane. You should also know that gas detectors can be purchased and installed in accordance with the instructions from the manufacturer. We have carbon monoxide, natural gas, and propane gas detectors in stock.

It is also very important that you advise your propane supplier of changes in your propane system and appliances. This applies to any and all work you perform, or that you authorize someone else to perform. Any person who authorizes someone other than your propane supplier to perform maintenance, repair, remove, install, adjust, or service any propane gas appliance, including, but not limited to, ranges, heat-producing devices, water heaters, containers, tanks or any part of the propane system, shall notify the propane supplier that one or more of the actions mentioned above has been performed on his or her own propane system prior to the system being placed back into service.
